Upon Receiving your order

> CHECK YOUR ORDER!

- Keep in mind your entire order may not arrive on the same day.
- Please call early regarding any concerns.

PULL ALL BAGGED PALMS OUT OF THE BOX!

- It is best to store all palms upright in their sealed bags.
- Avoid stacking bags flat on top of each other if possible.

> DO NOT TEAR BAGS OPEN YET!

 Wait until you are ready to use or arrange them. If bags are opened prematurely, it is best to reseal them with tape or clips until required.

➤ KEEP COOL!!

- Keep sealed bags of palms in cool area, 40-50 degrees is best!
- Florists, restaurants, or convenience stores often have refrigerated areas.
- O Do Not Freeze!!
- Do Not Put Near a Heat Source!!
- If no refrigerated space is available, keep in WELL-LIT, AIR-CONDITIONED space to prevent molding.

About Brown Tips

The leaf tip is the oldest part of the leaf as it grows on the plant. Brown tips are not the result of drying after harvesting. They indicate the rainfall that year, the nutrients in the soil, and the age of the leaf on the tree. Brown tips are naturally occurring and do not demonstrate that the leaf is "going bad".

It is important to understand that this is a naturally growing product, not manufactured, and that perfect tips do not exist in nature. Also, natural plants will exhibit differences in color distribution, shade, size, and shape.

About Brown Tips – Continued

Tips can be trimmed if you do not like the natural look of the leaf. Once placed in an arrangement, the tips are not noticeable and truly do add to the look of the leaf, not take away from it.

Additional Care Instructions

Mediterranean Processional Fans

Mediterranean Processional Fans are small fans with a bluish or gray tone to the leaves. Sometimes the leaves will have a white powder on the surface, but this is powder from the palm tree.

One to Three hours before using the leaves,

Cut each stem at a 45-degree angle just above the bottom end.

Place the stems in ICE WATER for at least 1 hour.

Hand Folded Palm Crosses

Crosses are made from the mature leaf of the Sabal Texana. Crosses will dry out in the open air much faster than strips and altar decor so please keep them cool and sealed in bag as long as possible.
